



## Appropriation (Annual) Act 2012

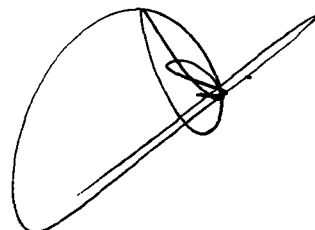
### Act No. 318

**An Act to appropriate certain sums of money out of the Niue Assembly account to the services for the year ending 30<sup>th</sup> June 2013 and to appropriate the supplies granted in that year.**

- 1 Title**  
This is the Appropriation (Annual) Act 2012.
- 2 Commencement**
  - (1) This Act shall relate to the financial year ending on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June 2013 (hereinafter referred to as “the financial year”).
  - (2) This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it becomes law in accordance with Article 34 of the Constitution.
- 3 Grant and Appropriate of Expenditure**

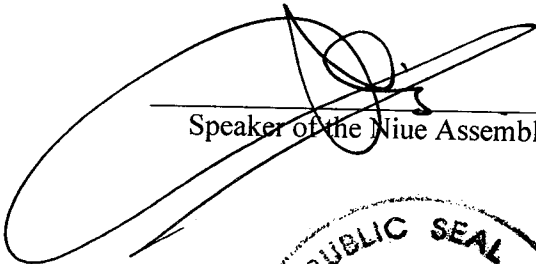
There may be issued and supplied from the Niue Assembly Account towards making good the supplies granted for the services of the financial year:

  - a) for Recurrent Operational Expenditure, Capital Projects and Investment and Development Projects a sum of which does not exceed \$25,754,000 in total; and
  - b) for development partner Investment and Development projects a sum which does not exceed \$18,298,000 in total particulars of which are set out under the relevant headings in the Schedules hereto.

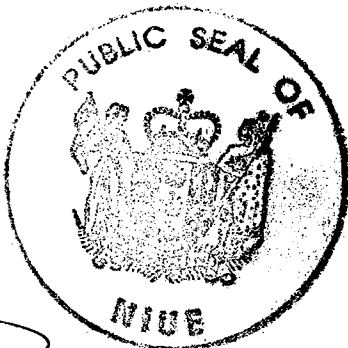
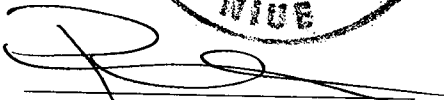
