1. Education Support Program Project Coordinator (one vacancy)	The PC will have the responsibility for the delivery of the project outcomes and activities in accordance with the project document and agreed work plan. He/she will coordinate the day-to-day implementation of the Program, coordinate and supervise the implementation of the Program and manage Program resources effectively and efficiently so as to deliver on the outputs on time in order to achieve the Program Objective and Outcomes within the established timeframe and available budget.
2. Senior School Teacher Year 4 – 6, Niue Primary School (one vacancy)	To work collaboratively with the Principal and other colleagues/teaching staff in order to attain the provision of a high standard of education that will cater for students learning needs at the Niue Primary School.

Intermediate Teacher – Niue High School (one vacancy)	The Intermediate Teacher will work in close collaboration with the Principal, the Intermediate Head of Department, the EMT, and other teachers and professionals to promote the learning and wellbeing of students by providing practical and classroom support to all students

This will ensure the delivery of a high-quality standard of education and ultimately an acceptable achievement of expected learning outcomes for all students at Niue High School in an equitable manner.</p>

Intervention Teacher – Niue High School (one vacancy)</p>	<p>The Intervention Teacher will work in partnership with teachers and other professionals to promote learning and welfare of students by providing practical and learning support to all students throughout the school. The Teacher will also work cooperatively with the Head of the Department, and other teachers to contribute positively towards the effective delivery of the curriculum content in order to ensure the provision of a high standard of education for students with special learning requirements and resources at Niue High School.</p>

<p>6. Vanilla – Crop Extension Officer (one vacancy)</p>	<p>Responsible for the management of all vanilla activities at Vaipapahi Agricultural Research Farm and assisting with client requests from Vanilla Farmers. Controlling and monitoring vanilla pollination and harvesting.</p>

Fisheries Trainee (one vacancy)</p>	<p>The Fisheries Trainee will work under direct supervision of the Principal Officer to achieve the functions and work program of the Fisheries in the following areas etc;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Collection and analysis of fisheries and marine resource data for scientific and management purposes; • Promotion of Community based fisheries management practices; • Maintenance of database on foreign fishing licenses and any other fishing arrangements between Niue and another entity;
