

## PENSIONS AND BENEFITS REGULATIONS 2011

No. 2011/ 3

**PURSUANT to Sections 4 and 19 of the Pensions and Benefits Act 1991 Cabinet makes the following regulations:**

### **1 Name**

These are the Pensions and Benefits Regulations 2011.

### **2 Interpretation**

In these regulations, "Act" means the Pensions and Benefits Act 1991.

### **3 Rate of Pension**

The rate of pension payable under section 4 of the Act is in the case of a person who has attained the age of 60 years \$5, 980 a year.

### **4 Rate of welfare**

The maximum rate of benefit for the purpose of section 13 of the Act is –

- a) In the case of a person considered by the Welfare Committee to be a person with a severe disability - \$2,210 a year; and
- b) In any other case - \$1, 950 a year.

### **5 Revocations**

- (1) The Pensions and Benefits Regulations 1998 are revoked.
- (2) The Pensions and Benefits Regulations 2009 are revoked.

# PENSIONS AND BENEFITS REGULATIONS 2011

**PURSUANT to Sections 4 and 19 of the Pensions and Benefits Act 1991 Cabinet makes the following regulations:**

## **1 Name**

These are the Pensions and Benefits Regulations 2011.

## **2 Interpretation**

In these regulations, "Act" means the Pensions and Benefits Act 1991.

## **3 Rate of Pension**

The rate of pension payable under section 4 of the Act is in the case of a person who has attained the age of 60 years \$5, 980 a year.

## **4 Rate of welfare**

The maximum rate of benefit for the purpose of section 13 of the Act is –

- a) In the case of a person considered by the Welfare Committee to be a person with a severe disability - \$2,210 a year; and
- b) In any other case - \$1, 950 a year.


## **5 Revocations**
