To fakatumau e Fakafiliaga Lahi ha Niue ke fakahoko e tau Fakafiliaga he Fakafiliaga holifono ke he tau Fakatufono pihia foki mo e Fakafiliaga Kelekele ne kua kotofa mo e gahua ki ai e tau Komisina Fakafili mo e tau Iki Fakafili he Mafola.

To fakahoko e taha Fakafiliaga mo e Iki Fakafili ke he puhala Zoom ke he aho 11 ia Fepuali 2021. Ko e Fakafiliaga nei kua fakahoko pauaki ai ke fakafili ni e falu a tohi ole mahuiga lahi.

To nakai fai Fakafiliaga mo e Iki Fakafili mai Niu Silani ka fakahoko ke he mahina ha Mati 2021.

To fakahoko ai fa e Fakafiliaga mo e Iki Fakafili ke he puhala Zoom ke he aho 12, 13, 14 mo e aho 15 ia Apelila 2021.

Ko e Iki Fakafili Lahi Craig T Coxhead ne kua kotofa ke gahua ke he tau Fakafiliaga nei ke he puhala Zoom ia Fepuali mo Apelila.

PRESS RELEASE: NIUE HIGH COURT SITTINGS 2021

Given the continuing Covid-19 restrictions in Niue, the Niue High Court intends to continue with Commissioner and Justice of the Peace Sittings and will now conduct two High Court Fixtures with sittings with a Judge, from New Zealand, by Zoom in February and April 2021.

The High Court intends to continue sittings for the Criminal and Land Divisions of the High Court where the Commissioners and Justices of the Peace will sit.

There will be 1 Court Sitting with a Judge by Zoom on 11th February.
This Sitting is restricted to priority applications listed for hearing.

There will no sittings with a Judge in the month of March in 2021.

There will be 4 Sittings with a Judge by Zoom on 12th, 13th, 14th and 15th April 2021.

Chief Justice Craig T Coxhead will preside over the sittings by Zoom in February and April 2021.

At this time, the Court cannot determine whether sittings with a Judge physically in Niue in November 2021 will be held and the Court will continue to monitor Covid-19 restrictions in Niue and announce those arrangements when they are able to be finalized..

Chief Justice Coxhead has issued Directions for the hearing before a Judge by Zoom and the Court in April will only deal with applications:

1. That are not opposed or are free of dispute
2. That do not require the calling of witnesses
