NIUE GOVERNMENT SURVIVES VOTE OF NO CONFIDENCE

Alofi, Niue – 22 March 2022 – The Niue Government has survived a vote of no confidence determined at a special session of the Niue Assembly today.

The motion was tabled by four Assembly members led by Common Roll member, Hon. Terry Coe.

Premier Tagelagi said the result speaks for itself in terms of his and his Cabinet's work since the election in 2020.

"A motion for a vote of no confidence is part of the democratic process and members exercising their rights as elected. My government has been working hard and provided steady leadership in navigating through a difficult pandemic that has had a devastating effect on Niue's economy."

"The result shows the confidence in my leadership and my Cabinet. We will continue to deliver on the priorities and keep Niue moving forward for everyone. This also means continuing with the careful and considered approach through COVID-19 and the pathway to economic recovery. We will continue to keep our people safe. Together, we will work to build a prosperous Niue."

The motion was defeated by 11 votes to 5.
