COVID-19 UPDATE: NO NEW CASES DETECTED AFTER DAY 7 TESTING

Alofi, Niue – 11 April 2022 – The Government of Niue (GON) announced today that all fully vaccinated arrivals in the MIQ Facilities had returned negative tests on day seven as part of standard testing protocols.

All 30 MIQ residents have returned negative tests after day seven of testing.

All active cases at the border are now recovered. Close contacts remain asymptomatic and continue to isolate at Homofiti until 17 April.

All quarantine locations other than Homofiti will be open for visitation from 1 pm to 7 pm. All visitors must wear face masks and maintain social distancing requirements as usual.

The second dose of the Pfizer and BioNTech (Comirnaty) rollout programme to vaccinate the 5 to 11-year-olds will be starting tomorrow, 12 April 2022. Niue is one of the few countries fully vaccinated over 99.4% of its eligible population aged 12 years and older.

Niue's National COVID response is now on Alert Level Blue, as there are no active cases in Niue.
