COVID-19 UPDATE: NO NEW CASES AFTER DAY SEVEN TESTING

Alofi, Niue – 26 April 2022 –The Government of Niue (GON) announced yesterday that all fully vaccinated arrivals in the MIQ Facilities had returned negative tests on day seven as part of standard testing protocols.

The one active border case continues to be monitored by health officials.

The passengers with negative tests have been released to their own place of residence to self-isolate for 3 days.

Homofiti MIQ remains closed to all visitors.

Niue's National COVID response remains on Alert Level Yellow, as there are no community cases and the positive case is contained at the border.
