COVID-19 UPDATE: ONE NEW CASE DETECTED AT THE BORDER

Alofi, Niue – 28 April 2022, 7.30 pm –The Government of Niue (GON) announced earlier today that all fully vaccinated arrivals in home isolation have returned negative tests on day nine as part of standard testing protocols.

This evening, following Day 3 testing for close contacts, a new case has been detected. The new case is an immediate close contact of the index case and was isolating separately in MIQ.

This new case brings our total active border cases to two.

The new case remains at Homofiti MIQ and has no symptoms for COVID-19. All close contacts and will be closely monitored by health officials.

Homofiti MIQ remains closed to all visitors.

Niue's National COVID response remains on Alert Level Yellow, as there are no community cases and the positive case is contained at the border.
