## **COVID-19 UPDATE: ALL NEW ARRIVALS INTO MIQ FACILITIES IN NIUE RETURN NEGATIVE DAY ONE TESTS**

**Alofi, Niue – 5 April 2022** – The Government of Niue (GON) announced today that all fully vaccinated arrivals currently in the MIQ Facilities have all returned negative tests on day one testing as part of standard testing protocols.

All 30 passengers who arrived on Monday, 5 April 2022 flight will be will be monitored and retested on Day 3 as per Niue’s testing protocols.

There are a total of five recovered cases from the border.

There are two remaining active cases at the border from the previous passenger flight and they remain asymptomatic and are at Homofiti.

All Quarantine sites remain closed to visitors until further notice, only drop offs are permitted.

Niue’s National COVID response remains on Alert Level YELLOW, as there are still two active cases in MIQ.
