COVID-19 UPDATE: NO NEW CASES DETECTED AFTER DAY 3 TESTING

Alofi, Niue – 7 April 2022 – The Government of Niue (GON) announced today that all fully vaccinated arrivals in the MIQ Facilities had returned negative tests on day three as part of standard testing protocols.

All 30 MIQ residents have returned negative tests after day three of testing.

There are two remaining active cases at the border from the previous passenger flight, and they remain asymptomatic and are at Homofiti.

All quarantine locations other than Homofiti, will be open for visitation from 1 pm to 7 pm. All visitors must wear face masks and maintain social distancing requirements as usual. Niue's National COVID response remains on Alert Level Yellow, as MIQ still has two active cases.
