NIUE POWER UPDATE #2

Alofi, Niue – 23 June 2022, 4.00 PM - The power supply has been restored to the southern side of the island and the northern side up to Matalave, Tuapa.

There continues to be no power supply from Matalave, Tuapa to Liku.

The Niue Power (NPC) staff are still working to locate exactly where the cable fault lies between Matalave and Mutalau.

Until this is resolved, there continues to be no power supply from Matalave to Liku.

NPC is still working on resolving the technical fault with the control system at the powerhouse with our partner in New Zealand.

The current power supply to the island is still provided directly from the generators as opposed to the battery system as usual.

It is therefore critical that consumers continue to reduce as much as possible the use of power.

Failure to reduce power usage could result in power rationing for the whole island. We humbly seek your cooperation in this matter.

Please treat all electrical appliances as if live and isolate them from the main supply.

We are mobilising a multi-ministry team to provide temporary water supply in villages without power.

Niue Power apologises for any inconvenience caused.
