## **THE GOVERNMENT OF NIUE PROCURES 4WD FLEET FOR THE MINISTRY OF INFRASTRUCTURE**

**Alofi, Niue – 30 January 2022** - The Government of Niue (GON) last week handed over three 4WD Toyota Hilux to the Ministry of Infrastructure to boost the work efforts of three divisions within the ministry.

Minister of Infrastructure, Hon. Crossley Tatui on behalf of the Government of Niue, officially handed over the vehicles to the Department of Transport (Outside Services and Heavy Plant) and the Department of Utilities (Civil and Quarry).

Hon. Tatui in his statement thanked Cabinet and the GON for supporting the procurement of these important vehicles to boost the work of the ministry as it has been long awaited. The Minister also encouraged the workers to look after these vehicles and hoped that these assets would help advance the essential work delivery of the ministry to the country and people of Niue.

These vehicles are expected to support the Government of Niue's efforts to improve infrastructure and services by strengthening the divisions' ability to provide essential services that are pivotal in providing quality services to the people of Niue.
