GOVERNMENT OF NIUE RENEWS MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR THE NIUE SHIP REGISTRY

Alofi, Niue – 04 March 2024 – The Minister of Finance and Infrastructure, Hon. Crossley Tatui is pleased to announce the renewal of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the Government of Niue and the Niue Ship Registry Pte Ltd on the 21st February 2024 in Singapore for the operation of the Niue Ship Registry.

The Niue Ship Registry Pte Ltd has played a crucial role in facilitating foreign vessel registration under the authority of the Government of Niue.

The recent renewal will extend the MOA for an additional 5-year period which marks a significant milestone in the ongoing partnership between the Government of Niue and the Niue Ship Registry Pte Ltd.



Since its establishment, the Niue Ship Registry has been a valuable source of revenue for the Government of Niue, with an estimated NZD\$ 3.7 million to assist with various projects and initiatives aimed at benefitting the government and the people of Niue.

The renewal of the MOA was formalized in the presence of Hon. Crossley Tatui, alongside key officials including Morgan Mougavalu, Director of Transport and, Justin Kamupala, Solicitor General.

Hon. Crossley Tatui expressed gratitude towards the Niue Ship Registry Pte Ltd, acknowledging their unwavering dedication and commitment to fulfilling the terms of the MOA. He emphasized the invaluable nature of their continued support and collaboration, highlighting their role in progressing the interests of the Niuean people and contributing to the nation's development objectives.
